FORGOTTEN MAN MINISTRIES

Men and women in the county jails are continuing to report what a difference the ministry of Jesus Christ through "Forgotten Man Ministries" has made in their lives. Through Bible Study classes, Bible Study correspondence courses, church services and spiritual one-on-one counseling, these men and woman are going to their prison sentences with the hope of eternal life. The message is that Christ does change lives!

Because of this, we are inviting you to participate in the fifth annual FMM Ironman Golf Tournament on June 6th at the Vassar Golf and Country Club, 3509 S. Kirk Rd., Vassar. Here's how it works:

- a. Gather a foursome to play or join one of the other teams to which you will be assigned.
- b. In order to play, each player must raise \$200.00 in one of two ways:
 1. The golfer seeks pledges for each hole played from each donor until he reaches a minimum of \$200.00
 2. The golfer collects flat donations until he reaches a minimum of \$200.00

An invoice will be sent to donors who have promised a pledged amount. The golfer is not responsible to collect the money. Each golfer will be given pledge sheets to write the name, address and phone number with amounts pledged or donated by the donor. Bring these pledge sheets and donations collected to the golf tournament. FMM will do the rest-invoices, receipts and thank-you notes.

† GOD'S SAFETY NET STILL HOLDS

Simon Peter went over and dragged the net ashore full of one hundred fifty-three large fish. Even though there were so many, the net was not torn. (John 21:11)

I picture the fish as people: family members and the hardships we have endured; families of new and changing parishes in our diocese and others; ecumenical organizations striving for a common understanding of Christ's life and word. The fish are nations and generations of humanity, each one fighting a battle between good and evil, life and death.

Scripture reminds us that even after his resurrection, Jesus came to comfort his people and increase the Church. We may follow two thousand years after this story, but the truth of God's care for us remains. Whenever it feels like the world is pulling us down or about to end, whenever it seems like our own nets are about to break, God is there, strengthening us and calling us to his eternal banquet.
