CSA-As we are now into the month of September, we must still deal with CSA. At this time-we are approximately \$4200 short of our parish assessment of \$58,000.00.

Weeks ago we sent letters to parishioners who had not responded to our CSA campaign. We have received some responses, yet there are a large number of parishioners who have not responded. And this is an issue for us –as a parish-to deal with.

As you know, the responsibility for payment of our CSA assessment belongs to the entire parish. Therefore, if we do not meet our assessment, the outstanding BALANCE is the responsibility of the parish. And there is the expectation/requirement of the parish to pay this balance to the Diocese.

For your information, we did NOT meet our assessment last year, and at this time there is an outstanding balance of \$9,000.00. We know the diocese is anticipating/expecting payment in the coming months.

If you have not responded to CSA, please do so as soon as possible. We do need your assistance. And we THANK the many parishioners who have made their contribution/pledge to CSA.
