FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Sacred Heart Church has a rich history in Caro. As a parish community, we have needs, goals, and aspirations for our parish and its members. Over the past several years, we have extensively researched and evaluated these needs, and together, have determined the need to improve and expand services for our youth as well as increase parish activities. As a parish, we are focused on solidifying our goals and visions to meet these needs.

“What can **WE** accomplish together?”

As a vision begins to take shape, we now pose the question to you: “What can **WE** accomplish together?” As you may know, there have been a great deal of research and evaluation of our parish, its current situation, and its needs for the future. As we have focused on our Parish Center, we have come to believe that a new building will be most cost-effective and will best serve our needs. This belief is driven by the fact that you have told us you would like to improve and expand Parish activities, especially those serving our youth. Our reasoning is spelled out on a chart currently situated in the main vestibule of the Church.

Naturally, a vision as ambitious as building a new Parish Center does not come without its price. That is why we are proposing the establishment of a **Sacred Heart Building Fund**, whose goal would be to raise enough revenue to begin building in approximately five years.

We believe that this is a unique moment in our parish history: we have shared in the shaping of a Vision for our future, and we now have the opportunity to realize it together. So, let us pose the question just one more time, with a bit of a twist: “What can **WE** (you and I and the **Lord**) accomplish together?”

Help us answer the question...let the members of your Parish Council and Planning Committee know how you will help make our shared vision a reality.
